**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSH CITY
TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS AND ISSUANCE
OF PERMITS RELATED TO PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, OR TRANSIENT
MERCHANTS DUE TO THE COVID-19 HEALTH PANDEMIC**

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, Minnesota Governor Tim Walz issued Executive Order 20-01 declaring a Peace Time Emergency and Coordinating Minnesota's Strategy to Protect Minnesotans from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rush City recognizes the risk COVID-19 poses to its residents and desires to do its part in protecting the residents of the community by temporarily limiting unnecessary contact through suspension of applications and issuance of permits related to peddlers, solicitors or transient merchants.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSH CITY, MINNESOTA, as follows:

1. A Peace Time Emergency related to the COVID-10 Health Pandemic exists within the State of Minnesota and in the City of Rush City, and
2. In an effort to enhance and promote social distancing, and so as to not impede an efficient response or compliance with federal and state directives or recommendations, no applications shall be accepted and no permits shall be issued as related to peddlers, solicitors, or transient merchants until such time that the City Council of the City of Rush City determines that the immediate threat has been contained.
